“ Greg was the closest neighbor from our Class of '61 ---- having lived on High Knoll Lane in Hidden Hills Subdivision in Brookfield we rode the same bus [#44] to High School every day We became closer friends in our Junior Year, as Greg played in Band and had his own little combo ---- knowing that I played the Bass, Greg often invited me to be a part of that Combo in our Senior year. As years passed we went our separate ways to College and into our own worlds. It wasn't until the last 15 years that we became close again - when he lived in NYC and I would come to the CITY to visit my Daughter and Family on Staten Island. We would meet for lunch Downtown or Uptown around 58th and Broadway. Sometimes he would take me to the Musician's Union Recording Hall off 7th Avenue --- He would speak of recording sessions with various groups and I would take it all in ! It was a precious time with Greg ! But even more precious was the 'very Frank' discussions we have had over the years via E-Mails Greg would rant and rave about the world situation [more directly focus on NYC than anything else] and about women in his life ... and jobs - or the lack thereof ... and teaching in early life right up until 20 20 quite a 'circle' ! ... I also remember his family back in Brookfield --- his father who had the service station on 92nd and Burliegh in Wauwatosa also remembered his Brother Brian in a very faint way Greg was seen as a lost child --- heavy into his Music and yet quite popular and accepted at BHS thru Sports and Music Something about his general demeanor that I appreciated - quite unassuming and yet opinionated at every turn when engaged !
Fond memories of GREG WATERS and I do miss him already

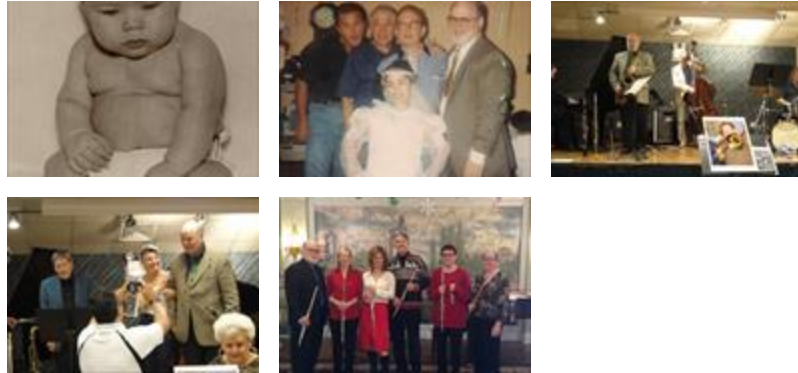
