Our hearts are saddened with the sudden loss of our beloved sister, Irene.

The care she administered to her patients was a daily priority, and she was always complimented by the families of the patients for whom she cared. Additionally, Irene's colleagues also recognized her dedication and professionalism and depended upon her knowledge and compassion when ever she was summoned to assist in the "Code Blues" in the emergency room. As Irene's personal health suffered in many ways, after her active nursing career, her needs for assistance became the priority of my sister, Diane, and myself these past several years. She would often express her sadness in not being able to independently meet several of her own needs.

"I was the nurse who took care of my patients." Indeed she was the nurse who did just that. But as her sisters, Diane and I learned from Irene's example, and from those compliments about her patient care, fell to our ears. We knew what we would share in caregiving to our sister. Our love for her made it immediately obvious, that we would each wear our individual "invisible nursing caps" and follow in her shoes, giving HER the care she required that each of us could provide, backed up with the understanding of our respective families. She was always grateful to each of us, and knew how much we loved her. On the the morning of All Souls Day, when Irene passed away, the words "I love you," were spoken to her by us over and over, and we will never stop. Our gratitude to the Gottlieb ER staff, who honored Irene's nursing practice, and memory, with Irene's own caring style, while they cared for our loving sister during her final moments of life.
